We are seeking to fill a tenure-track assistant professor position in Research, Measurement & Statistics, with expertise in any related area of psychometric theory and educational statistics, preferably in (but not limited to) Bayesian modeling, data mining, network analysis, nonparametric statistics, experimental and quasi-experimental designs, meta analysis, or intensive longitudinal analysis. Upper-level assistant professors with a strong record in research and grant writing are encouraged to apply. The successful applicant will join a team of nationally-recognized tenure-track faculty who publish in top-tier journals and run multiple research grants. We seek applicants with well-defined programs of research, who have demonstrated expertise or promise in obtaining extramural funding, and who are dedicated to high-quality graduate teaching and mentoring. The Department of Educational Psychology and College of Education and Human Development are especially interested in qualified candidates who can contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community through their research, teaching, and/or service.
