The Department of Educational Psychology at Texas A&M University offers a **Special Education** emphasis for students in two programs: Interdisciplinary Studies (INST) and as a Second Teaching Field for Secondary Education students.

This emphasis provides

- ★ PK-12 certification in Special Education for INST majors.
- ★ Emphasis on addressing individual differences in inclusive classroom settings.
- ★ Field experiences with students including those with special needs in classroom and community settings.

Due to the intensive nature of the program, students must be formally admitted to the Special Education Program. Admissions to the Undergraduate Special Education program are made twice a year—admission to the fall semester cohort and admission to the spring semester cohort. Each cohort is limited to 30 students. Admission to the Undergraduate Special Education Program is based on the following criteria:

Minimum qualifications for admission:

- ★ Be a second semester sophomore in the process of applying for admission to teacher education
- ★ Maintain a cumulative GPR of 2.5
- ★ Have earned at least a B in INST 310 and SPED 302
- ★ Successfully completed admission procedures required by the Special Education Undergraduate Committee
